

Stoun age museum, Lepenski Vir

Lepenski Vir (Lepen Whirl) is an important Mesolithic archaeological site located in Serbia in central Balkan peninsula The latest radiocarbon and AMS data suggests that the chronology of Lepenski Vir is compressed between 9500/7200-6000 BC. There is some disagreement about the early start of the settlement and culture of Lepenskir vir. But the latest data suggest 9500-7200 to be the start. The late Lepenskir Vir (6300-6000 B.C.) architectural development was the development of the Trapezoidal buildings and monumental sculpture[1] The Lepenskir Vir site consists of one large settlement with around ten satellite villages. Numerous piscine sculptures and peculiar architecture are testimony to a rich social and religious life led by the inhabitants and the high cultural level of these early Europeans.

Golubac fortress

Viminacium – Entering the archeological site of Viminacium, the most valuable remains of **Roman empire** like military camp, bones of an Serbian mammoth, and public thermal bath.


Zajecar is also famous for museum in which you could find preserved artifacts from Felix Romuliana – Roman city, and not only that, but many artifacts from the rich history of Serbian people.



Felix Romuliana - is an archaeological site, and UNESCO World Heritage Site of Serbia, located south of the Danube River.
