Module 1:

Traveling Workshop & Connection Working Days 1-4 Arrival, 20th of July, Departure 25th of July

Day 1, 21st July, Novi Sad:

- Opening Session: Introduction to CRISPACE, objectives, and expected outcomes.
- Media, Digital, and Al Skills Overview: Key concepts and current trends relevant to space infrastructure and interdisciplinary projects.
- Mentorship & Practical Exercise 1:
 - Participants are grouped into diverse teams to work on mini projects.
 - Mentorship pairing: Experienced leaders mentor groups, focusing on collaboration skills and problem-solving.
 - Exercise: Developing a digital/media-based communication plan for a hypothetical space project.



Day 2, 22nd July, Novi Sad:

- Workshop: Building effective networking and team-building skills through simulated scenarios.
- Practical Exercise 2: Digital toolkit development: Participants create digital resources or tools to support project communication.
- Mentorship & Feedback: Real-time feedback from mentors on teamwork and digital tools used.



Day 3, 23rd July, Novi Sad-Belgrade:

- Training Module: Integrating media, digital, and AI solutions into project management and communication.
- Practical Exercise 3: Design and presentation of a digital or Al-based project component.
- Networking Activity: Peer review and cross-team collaboration.

Day 4, 24th July, Belgrade:

- Workshop: Advanced skills in media literacy and knowledge management for project sustainability.
- Mentorship & Practical Exercise 4: Simulation of crisis communication or stakeholder engagement using media and AI tools.
